Scout Activities

Supervised rope tasks and construction projects to ensure safety and structural integrity.



Archery

Safe shooting zones and mandatory protective gear for all participants.



Swimming

Certified lifeguards and mandatory floatation devices for inexperienced swimmers.



STEM Activities

Non-toxic, age-appropriate materials and expert supervision during tool use.



Environmental and Sustainability Measures

Eco-Friendly Practices

Strict "Leave No Trace" guidelines and recycling stations throughout the camp.

Wildlife Conservation

Avoidance of interference with natural habitats and educational sessions on biodiversity.

Participant Responsibilities

Mandatory safety briefings and prompt reporting of unsafe conditions.

Sports and Adventure

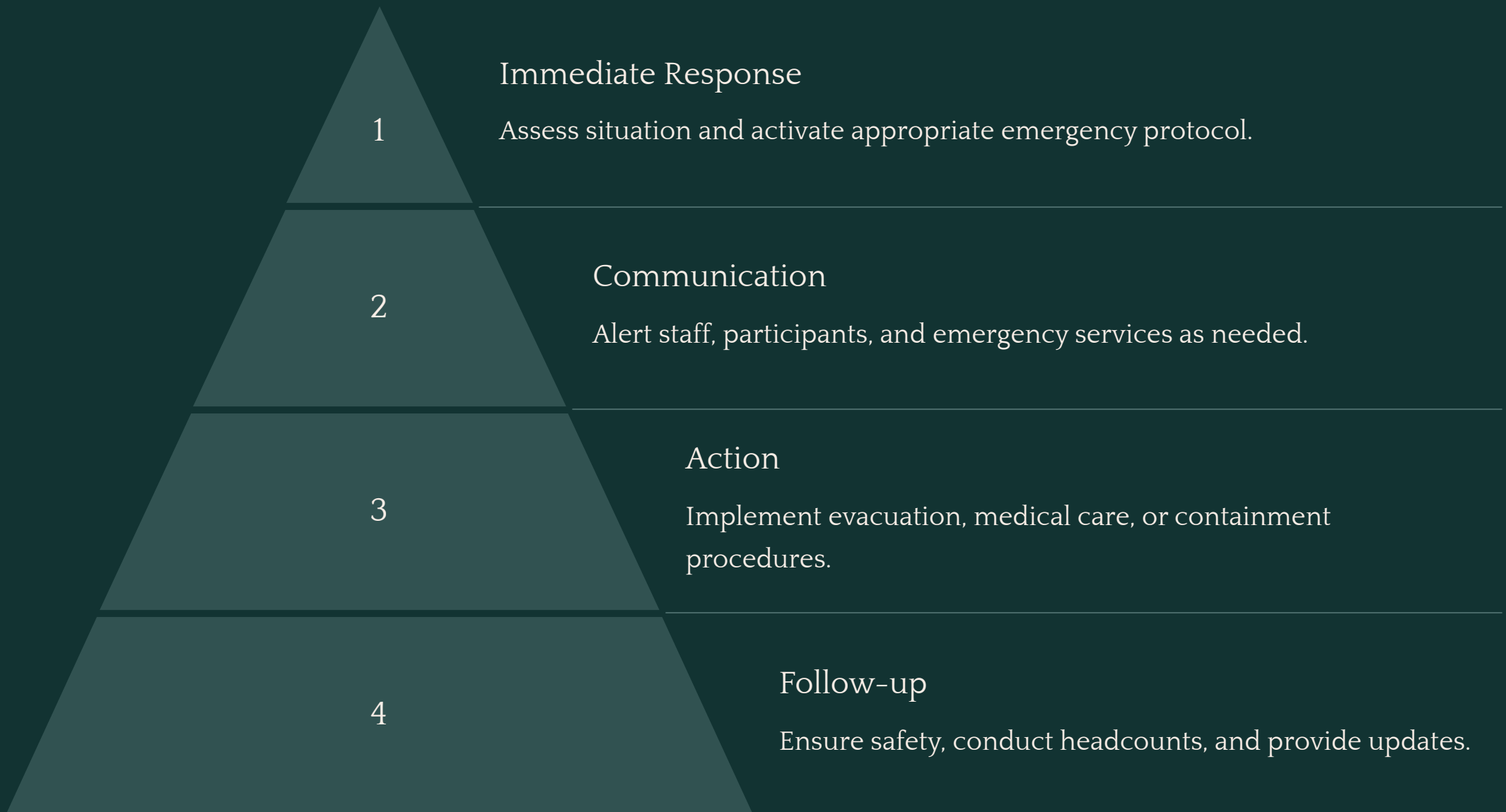
Warm up properly, use protective gear, stay alert, and report any discomfort to instructors.
